A math collaboration meeting was held in November, which included math teachers from Lehi High, Lehi Jr. High and Willowcreek Middle School. The Algebra 2 state core was opened and broken down piece by piece. A one year plan was put into place, laying out all key concepts to be taught. It will not matter which school students attend, the Algebra 2 concepts are the same. Although they may be taught differently, students should gain the same knowledge and be able to transition from one school to the next. The goal for next year is to do the same in Geometry.

Mr. Openshaw presented the December practice CRT scores. The comparisons between September and December practice CRT scores are as follows:

Science 7	47%	60%
Science 8	46%	57%
Earth Systems	37%	43%
Biology	50%	53%

Today, teachers in science department meeting will receive their student breakdown scores. As a department, they will discuss these scores and what they can do to improve on the next practice CRT test.

Teachers in the math department have already received the breakdown of what each individual student scored on the practice test. In collaboration meeting, they have been discussing how they can improve scores on the next practice CRT test.

At the end of term 1, the pass rate comparisons are as follows:
