Elections—The process for 2008-09 School/Community elections are underway. Applications have been accepted for the open spot in Eagle Mountain, Cedar Valley, and Lehi areas. Voting for the positions will be done through a ballot at Parent/Teacher Conferences On February 21, 2008.

A representative from Willowcreek’s School/Community Council and Mr. Openshaw will attend each meeting. Mr. Openshaw will give the elementary presentations. This will allow time to help educate members of our Walkaway program, making the transition easier for students coming into middle school.

English Data—Mr. Openshaw presented data from the common assessment for English. For English 7, the class average was 80 percent, English 8 had a class average of 73 percent, and for English 9, it was 83 percent. Scores for 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade were expected to fall in this range. 8<sup>th</sup> grade scores dropped a little, which was to be expected. The English department was effected by the Administrative changes made at the beginning of the second semester. Since, students seem to be adjusting to the changes made. A practice CRT test will be given the end of February.

Trust Lands—Proposals for 2008-09 Trust Land budget were discussed. Ideas from the last meeting were: \$25,000 for a .5 FTE intern counselor, \$18,000 to continue the after school Tuesday program running, \$6,000 to help run after school Tuesday buses, \$13,000 to continue the “Go My Access” software, money to help with the guided studey hall
