

# 2009-2010 School Year Utah School Registration Immunization Requirements

Utah State Law requires that all students must submit a completed immunization record to the school ***BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL ATTENDANCE. THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE IN EFFECT FOR THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR IN ALL UTAL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS.*** A student must have proof of the following immunizations for school enrollment or submit one of the three exemptions listed below from the Health Department.

## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 7<sup>TH</sup> - 9<sup>TH</sup> GRADES

<p>5 DTP/Dtap/DT/Tdap</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4 doses ok if 4<sup>th</sup> given after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday</li> <li>• 3 doses ok if 3<sup>rd</sup> given after 7<sup>th</sup> birthday</li> </ul> <p>1 Tdap (tetanus, pertussis)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Given within last 5 years-must have been given after age 7</li> </ul> <p>4 Polio (OPV/IPV)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 doses ok if 3<sup>rd</sup> given after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday</li> </ul> <p>2 MMR (mumps, measles and rubella)</p> <p>3 Hepatitis B (HBV)</p> <p>2 Hepatitis A (HAV)</p> <p>1 Varicella (chickenpox)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• History of disease ok-parent must sign pink immunization card.</li> <li>• If student is 12 years old 2 doses are required</li> </ul>

## EXEMPTIONS

MEDICAL	RELIGIOUS	PERSONAL
Forms can be signed at a doctor's office and attached to the pink immunization card.	Completed waiver form from the local health department must be signed and attached to the pink immunization card.	Completed waiver form from the local health department must be attached to a parent-signed pink immunization card.

*A child may be allowed to attend school "conditionally" if at least one dose of each required immunization series has been completed and the child is **currently on schedule** to finish the rest. The remaining immunizations must be **completed on schedule** for the child to remain in attendance.*
