

## Willowcreek Middle School

School/Community Council Meeting  
Monday, August 18, 2008 - Noon

Natalie Petersen welcomed the group to the first School/Community Council meeting of the 2008-09 school year. Jen Betts read the minutes from the April meeting. The Minutes were voted on and approved.

Introductions of members were given. For the 2008-09 school year, Mr. Browning, introduced himself to the council, wanted to let everyone know that he is honored to be the principal at Willowcreek Middle School. He also thanked Natalie Petersen, and Mr. Openshaw on a job well done with School Community Council.

Total funding received from School Land Trust Program \$148,817. The estimate for school funding is \$64,676. Estimated funding for 2009 may be adjusted after the October 1, 2008 fall enrollment count.

During the 2008-09 school year, Willowcreek Middle school will improve school-wide CRT scores 2% on the state CRT tests in Math, Language Arts and Science using the 2007-08 scores as the base line. The Trust Land money will be used in the following ways

to reach this goal. \$10,000 to purchase two classroom sets of graphing calculators, \$15,700 will be used to help purchase another computer lab to be used in Math, Language

Arts and Science classes, \$18,000 will be used to pay teachers outside of contract time to stay after work on Tuesdays to work with students that need help, \$8,000 will be used to cover late buses to be used to get those students home that stay and work with teachers

after school, \$13,000 to be used to cover the cost of Vantage Learning System software to help students with their Language Arts skills.

Lehi: Some concerns regarding Walk Aways, they are feeling they are coming along a lot better than anticipated.

Saratoga Springs: No concerns

Eagle Valley: Questions on Walk Aways.

Eagle Mountain: Concerns on how Walk Aways will affect the students when they go to High School. Mr Browning, will continue discussing this with the High School, in attempting to work through any concerns.
